The Law of the Spirit

Prior to the Creation everything that existed merely as a Divine possibility latent with energy and creation principles, ready to receive the Creative Word that shall cause it to spring into definite forms. The entire Bible from the first letter of the Old Testament to the last letter of the New Testament, when the scriptures were put together in the form of the Bible were taken from scrolls written by God's chosen servant, was one continued sentence. Today, from our English teachings, we would call this one long run on sentence. The scriptures had no spaces. The Bible is one long sentence, in code, that was written in Hebrew in the Old Testament and Greek in the New Testament. This is important to note because God's original language, and still his own language today is Hebrew. Greek was a new language at the time of writing the New Testament. This meant that the language of God was used for the Old Testament and the language of man was used for the New Testament. Both Testaments were written by human beings filled with the spirit of God.

When you understand that the whole Bible was written from the spirit of God transferred into the spirit of man, then you must then understand what man did was write what God was thinking. So, the Bible is the thoughts of God – His Spirit and His Energy. For us as humans, we are told that we should do the following.

2 Timothy 2:15 "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

Matthew 4:4 "But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God."

When we look to God through prayer or in reading His word we must be in the same consciousness as God. In other words, we must think like God in order to understand what God is telling us. This is called comprehending the mind of God. We obtain this comprehension through His word and understanding what His words, the scripture, means. We must translate His original words from Hebrew into our English language to properly understand what God is telling us through His written thoughts.

Hebrew was written backwards to us English speaking people. This means the we write and speak words left to right. Hebrew is written and spoken right to left. So, to be able to think like God we need to begin to speak right to left. In reading the Bible, our English translation, took the Hebrew words and Greek words and translated them into English and wrote the Bible left to right. This is not the way the Bible was written. It was written right to left. It was God's thoughts. In addition, being one continuance sentence all letters had no spaces. So, when you read the Bible, you must look at the scripture as written for us but interpret from right to left.

Let us give you an example. In Genesis 1:2 it says, "And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters."

The word and written from right to left would give us the word DNA. We would then have to take each word back to Hebrew to look at the meaning of the English word in Hebrew to actual understand this verse of scripture.

It is important that we comprehend God's thoughts to properly understand the thoughts of God to create the knowledge that leads to wisdom which we live our lives by.

Hosea 4:6 "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children."
